The scholarship is awarded in the memory of Dennis R. Casale who was an AFHF Board Member and parent of a field hockey player.

Mr Casale was an attorney and Co-Managing Partner of the Princeton, NJ office of Pepper Hamilton LLP who pass away this past August. He was a 1978 Cum Laude Graduate Of Seton Hall Law School, where he had the distinction of graduating first in his class. A former Deputy Attorney General for The State of New Jersey, Mr. Casale also served as president of the Lawrence Township Board of Education for five years. In addition, he also served as a parent volunteer with the Spirit Eagles Field Hockey Group.

The \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a college bound student-athlete who best exemplifies the same qualities Dennis exhibited during his life - leadership, community service, desire, commitment and academic success.
